



How to “Register as a Fundraiser”

Here are the steps...

Register as a Fundraiser

Add +

⑤ Pay what you can

This option is for participants who will be creating a fundraising page. Set the fundraising goal that works for you.

Here you have 2 options on how to start:

- Click “Add+” to immediately register – you can enter any amount as a start. Following registration, you will receive confirmation email with a link to create or join a team. This will automatically create the fundraising page in your name so you can track the donations that come in from your supporters making up the \$75 full fee.

- It is most welcome if you raise more than \$75!

OR

- You can go straight to this link Create/Join a team and the process will immediately create your own fundraising page. This is the link: <https://www.kahcanada.org/team>

- You will receive an email with a direct link to your own fundraising page. This can then be shared with your circle of friends and family. Your supporters will be happy to contribute!

- Once you reach your fundraising goal, send us an email notification, and we’ll complete the registration for you.
